What is AGPT?

Australian General Practice Training (AGPT) provides support to Registrars to achieve Fellowships of ACRRM or RACGP (FRACGP and FARGP). Completing [AGPT](#) is an essential component of the Rural Generalist Program.

What is an RTO?

Regional Training Organisations are funded by the Commonwealth Department of Health to deliver the AGPT Program. GPTQ is your SE QLD RTO.

5 things you need to know about your GP training:

1. Whilst the QRGP Team manages your progress through the Rural Generalist Pathway, the RTO supports your GP training component.
2. Applicants enrolled on the Rural Generalist Pathway are required to preference **Rural Pathway**.
3. Rural Generalist Trainees should preference the RTO where they intend to complete ALL of their training.
4. Positions in Qld Health Advanced Skills Training (AST) in Procedural (Anaesthetics and Obstetrics) and non-Procedural (e.g. Paediatrics, Internal Medicine and Mental Health) disciplines are coordinated by QRGP and applications usually open early May each year. GPTQ is in a position to offer Hospital training at a variety of metropolitan and regional Hospitals for undertaking Hospital or Core Clinical Training and Advanced Skills Training terms.
5. GPTQ's region has accredited rural hospitals and practices where Registrars can complete their General Practice and Primary Rural and Remote training terms.
